PRINCE2 (an acronym for PRojects IN Controlled Environments) is a de facto process-based method for effective project management.



Used extensively by the UK Government, **PRINCE2** is also widely recognised and used in the private sector, both in the UK and internationally.

The **PRINCE2** method is in the public domain, and offers non-proprietary best practice guidance on project management

KEY FEATURES OF PRINCE2

- Focus on business justification
- Defined organisation structure for the project management team
- Product-based planning approach
- Emphasis on dividing the project into manageable and controllable stages
- Flexibility that can be applied at a level appropriate to the project.
